1903 Curve Dash Oldsmobile, displayed by Peter and Debbie Stephens, Dublin, Ohio. Debbie is the Great Grand Daughter of Ransom E. Olds.

1908 Buick Model 10, displayed by Guy and Anita Bennett, Wayland, New York. Guy and Anita own the oldest Buick family dealership in the United States.

1934 Cadillac V-16 Convertible, displayed by Steven Plunkett, London, Ontario, Canada.

1953 Buick Skylark Convertible, displayed by Jeff and Angie Brashares, Dublin, Ohio.

1955 Corvette, from the Bob McDorman collection. This is the famous Duntov Corvette raced at GM’s proving grounds at speeds exceeding 150 mph.

1963 Chevrolet Impala, displayed by Rick Schmidt, Ocala, Florida. This is the 50,000,000th Chevrolet with less than 100 miles on it.

1978 Buick Riviera LXXV Anniversary Edition, displayed by Bill Anderson, Gambrills, Md. Only 2,899 were produced.
